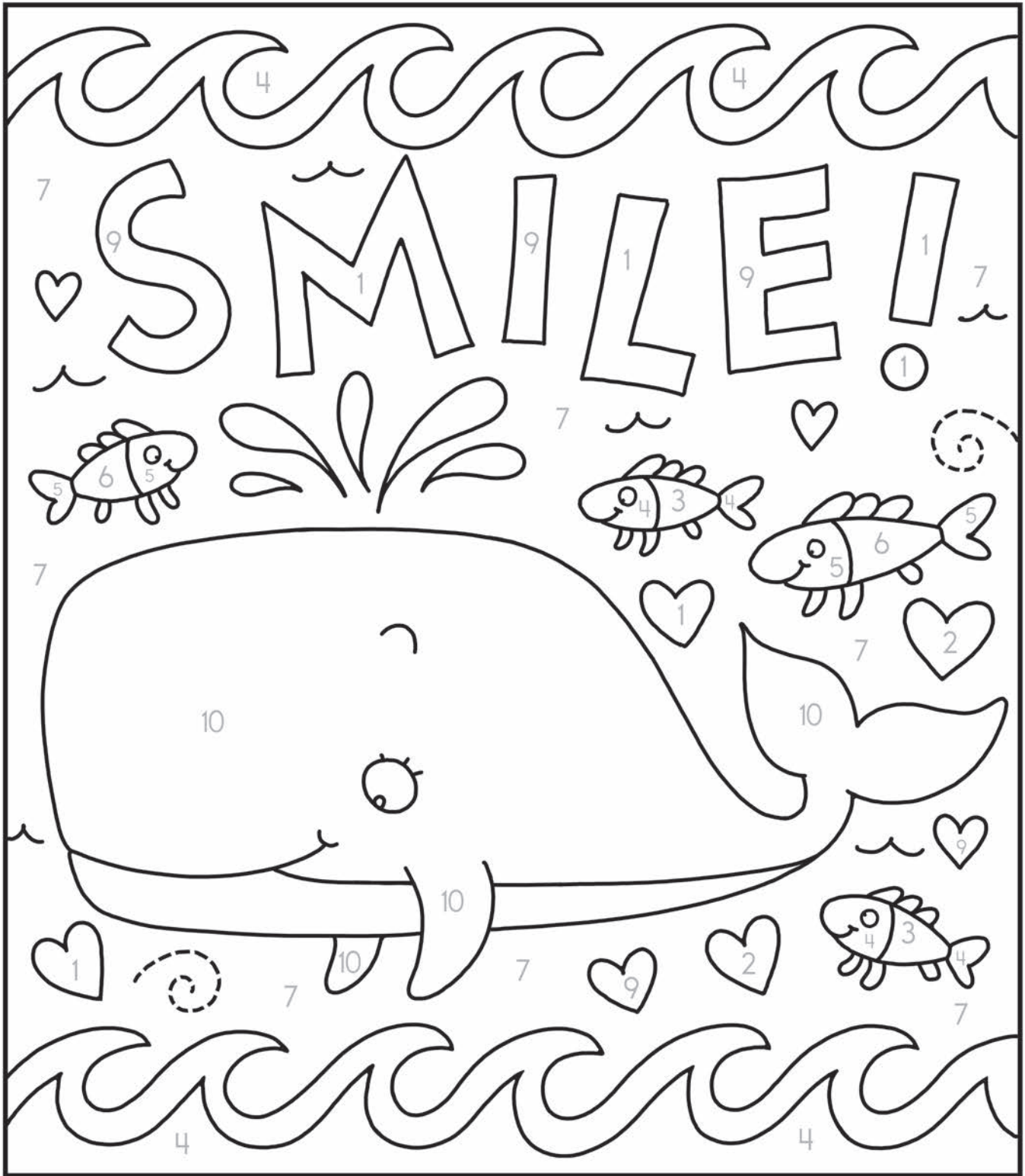
Lamplighter (ca. 1775)

Only the biggest colonial cities had streetlights. Installation began in the years preceding the American Revolution. Philadelphia had streetlights installed and operating by 1762. In addition to lighting lamps in the evening and extinguishing them at dawn, the lamplighter cleaned lamps, trimmed wicks, and filled pans with oil. This lamplighter is filling the oil pan of a streetlight in Philadelphia.
